






From 2005 to 2015, Kazakhstan has attracted over 208 bln Usd of foreign direct investments, ranking just at 2° place after Russian Federation within the CIS area.







Italy, on 2016, has exported to Kazakhstan goods for **845 millions Euros**, with a growing trend compared to former years.

Almost 50% of Made in Italy exports to Kazakhstan has been represented by investment goods, particularly by machinery and plants for the Oil & Gas, minerary and metallurgy sectors. We are talking about good sold as multiannual payments.

The main Italian players operating in this sectors are:

Oil & Gas: Eni

**Oil & Gas services** (services and construction): Saipem, Tenaris, Rosetti Marino, Bonatti, Sicim.

**General constructions, real estate and construction materials:** Salini Impregilo, Renco e Italcementi.

**Industrial and civil trasports: CNH-IVECO** 

**Consumer goods**: representing 35% of global Italian export to the Kazakh market, they concern fashion, accessories and home furniture.

Eni has been present in Kazakhstan since 1992 in the Exploration & Production sector.

Eni is co-operator of the Karachaganak field and partner in the North Caspian Sea Production Sharing Agreement (NCSPSA), which is in charge of Kashagan operations and holds a 50% interest for exploration and production activities of the Isatay block, located in the Kazakh sector of the Caspian Sea.

**Kashagan** field with the completion of works to fully replace the damaged pipelines following the gas leak occurred at the end of 2013.

The production capacity of 370 kbbl/d planned for the Phase 1 is expected to be achieved during 2017, when gas reinjection comes online.

Karachaganak field production averaged 231 kbbl/d of liquids (61 kbbl/d net to Eni) and 925 mmcf/d of natural gas (247 mmcf/d net to Eni).











Bonatti works in Kazakhstan since 2000 realizing huge EPC projects such as the Bolashak onshore plant for **Kashagan** and maintenance and construction works like in **Karachaganak** on behalf of KPO, as well as in **Tengiz** for TCO (Sulphur Forming Units (Tengiz); del Kulsary pipeline (124 km).

Bonatti has recently completed the **New Kashagan Trunklines System** by substituting two parallel pipelines (2 x 45,2 km offshore; 2 x 26,1 km onshore and 2 x 4,1 km on shallow waters) connected to onshore plant of Bolashak/Karabatan. Bonatti has provided the best solutions by adopting innovative welding methods: "Bonatti's Pipe Mechanized Welding System ROB.E-10.01".

Saipem has been operating in Kazakhstan since 1995, particularly in the Northern Caspian Sea area, for the development of 11 blocks of Kashagan oil & gas field, which has been the first huge offshore project in Kazakhstan. Saipem has completed on behalf of Agip KCO several engineering, construction and installation contracts and it's been also operating by offshore drilling platforms in the North-Western Area.

**ERSAI Caspian Contractor LLC** is the 100% Kazakh company founded on 2003, between Saipem and ERC Holding. ERSAI is based in Almaty.

One of the most recent awards is the **1.8 bln USD** engineering & construction contract for NCOC to build 2 pipelines of 28" and 95 km from Kashagan D-Island to Karabatan.




Last three years CNH Industrial in Kazakhstan produced:

#### Last three years contracts concern:

- 358 urban bus *Citelis* Euro V (diesel) on 2015, 210 *Urbanway* Euro VI (diesel) and *Urbanway Hybrid* of 12 and 18 mt. on 2017, which makes IVECO BUS to be leader of the segment in the Kazakh market, with a total number of around 570 bus operating in Astana.

**Number of employees (Kazakh and Expatriates):** employees are mainly out of Kazakhstan, where anyway 8 Kazakh engineers are working to ensure all after-sales services.















IVECO BUS has delivered the first batch of Urbanway buses to Astana LRT LLP, the municipal transport company. The global supply contract includes 210 Urbanway Euro VI and Urbanway Hybrid 12-meter and 18-meter buses for the city's public transport system.



Todini arrived in Kazakhstan in the first 90s executing many transport infrastructures projects like:
